  Well Maintenance company, to terminate the contract for maintenance on Village Wells. The

Mr. McClellan has obtained costs involved for the rehabilitation, and upgrades to the current runways. He has met with the execs at the Donrovin Resort, explaining the "local match" for such a project would be impossible for the Village to afford. The approximate cost to rehab, and upgrade could reach \$4,000,000.00 or more.

A roll call vote was taken, President Truxton, Aye., T. Jannereth, Aye. C. Miller, Aye. And C. Vicent, Aye. All Ayes, 0 Nays, 1 absent. Motion carried.
